Clinical Updates in Pediatric Practice

Overview:

The achievement of excellence in pediatric health care practices and patient/family outcomes requires on-going knowledge and implementation of evidence-based practices.

The goal of this program is to explore contemporary practices related to the care of children with behavioral health challenges or chronic illnesses and to provide evidence-based information and tools for learners to incorporate into their own pediatric practices.

Target Audience

Pediatric nurses and healthcare providers caring for children in a variety of settings

Learning Outcomes:
